Littlehampton Welding Limited has a clear direction for its business, part of which is our commitment to the environment and the reduction of our impact upon it.

We recognise our responsibilities to the wider environment and to the local community. We are committed to comply with all relevant environmental legislation at local, regional and national level as a minimum performance, and to continually improve our environmental responsibilities through appropriate initiatives, controls, recycling, the provision of resources and continuous training of our employees. We are also committed to any additional requirements originating from other external sources which relate to our environmental aspects. We have established our Environmental Management System to mirror the International Standard ISO 14001:2015. Guided by our system we are committed to conduct our operations to a clear and consistent policy for environmental protection. We have defined an Environmental Policy that includes these commitments and sets out the intentions and principles for environmental performance.

Our objectives and targets are established and reviewed on a regular basis to implement and maintain our environmental policy. These are based upon six core commitment environmental principles:

- Prevention and the reduction of pollution expressed in all its forms;
- Minimisation of energy and material usage and the production of waste;
- Effective and responsible waste management and disposal by maximising environmental solutions;
- Promoting economical use of all raw materials and recycling in all office and manufacturing processes;
- Maintaining high workforce awareness of environmental issues as an ongoing requirement;
- Involving suppliers, contractors and customers in environmental initiatives at an early stage in all contracts.

Our environmental management systems' effectiveness is monitored and maintained by regular internal and external audits, by formal management review and are updated as and when necessary. Our Environmental Policy is communicated to all employees and made available to the public upon request. The involvement of our workforce and external interested and affected parties in our Environmental Policy is encouraged by the organisation through effective communication procedures.
